

## DCHPII: Digital Cultural Heritage - Platforms and Inventories of the Intangible

Report 11/2016 - 11/2019

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Under the project *Digital Cultural Heritage - Platforms and Inventories of the Intangible* (DCHPII), between 2016 - 2019, theoretical and practical research has been conducted on the inventorying of Intangible Cultural Heritage (ICH) and on the treatment of ICH cultural expressions on digital platforms.

Organized in 3 Working Groups (WGs): 1) Management; 2) Participatory inventorying and 3) Digital Platforms, the DCHPII project carried out actions on the following work areas (as proposed in the research plan):

- Identify, mapping and realize a comparative study of Digital ICH inventories considering the most relevant projects;
- Research on practices and representations of different social actors about participatory ICH inventories: public bodies, civil society associations, private entities, researchers, NGOs, cultural institutions, museums, different scientific communities;
- Research on Intangible Cultural Heritage approaches through different scientific disciplines (Humanities; Social Sciences and Information and Communication Technology - ICT);
- Analysis how local communities and groups are involved in the processes of ICH inventorying (considering the cases studied);
- Analysis online systems in use for the management of ICH digital archives (data structure, multimedia data, digital platform, tools to interact, access, interfaces, manage multimedia; ethical and legal issues);
- Implement an international platform the Digital ICH Observatory about ICH issues and promote new services of Digital ICH inventories;

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- Work in transferring knowledge from academia to Memória Imaterial - a non-governmental organization linked to civil society, work in ICH inventory and promote new services of Digital ICH inventories;
- Work with multi-disciplinary ICH networks.

**Through DCHPII we have already reached the following outcomes:**

- 1) **The “Digital ICH Observatory” and the “Digital ICH Chanel”** - platforms to produce, share and expose scientific works about ICH and Digital Cultural Heritage;
- 2) **A DCHPII Online Platform for mapping Digital ICH inventories** –193 countries analysed – more then 170 e-inventories mapped;
- 3) **Scientific publications** to disseminate the results of research, mapping and the characterisation of ICH inventories - International Publications - 1 book; coordination of 3 issues of an international scientific journal; 1 book chapter publications and other 4 publications (articles and reports). National publications – 1 book chapter publication and 1 multimedia resource – DVD + digital platform;
- 4) **9 participations in international and national conferences**, 5 as keynote or invited speaker (international);
- 5) **10 Meetings and Short-term scientific missions** with networks - ICH NGOs forum and ICH museums project -, UNESCO organizations (International and National Commission) and other entities;
- 6) **Work in transferring knowledge from academia to Memória Imaterial - a non-governmental organization linked to civil society**; work in ICH inventory – 1 project and promote new services of Digital ICH inventories – 2 capacity-building courses;
- 7) **Tutoring** – 1 professional Internship mentor and 1 research grant mentor;
- 8) **Other publications and other dissemination activities**: the Newsletter of the project; the Digital ICH Community and network, the Facebook page of the project and presence in national daily newspapers.
